This Code of ethics provides recommendations on how to participate in the PhD & Career Development MOOC.

Participants are politely invited to:

- be friendly and respectful of other points of views, especially in discussions.
- interact with, encourage and motivate your peers, sharing information openly and widely
- accept that you are responsible for the content of the documents, messages and information that you put on the MOOCit platform.
- post useful messages whose content is related to the topics of the MOOC.
- avoid any advertisement, any slanderous or offensive language. The MOOC organizers reserve the right to take measures against anyone who does not follow this rule.
- cite your sources and reference the information you post online, to respect scholarship standards and intellectual property.
- consult and print the content of the MOOC and its resources only if you want to use it for sharing and learning purposes, outside of any commercial purpose (remember that you can use this material but don't own it).
- learn about the <u>CC BY-NC-SA license</u> which governs the use of the data shared by participants on the MOOC platform.
- provide any critical feedback in a **constructive** way, with the aim to improve the MOOC with all its participants through supportive collaboration.
- note that the MOOC organizers reserve the right to take measures against any participant who would not comply with the laws and rules in effect.
